These settings can also be specified using the *w2* application characteristic [OMAW2] in an OMA CP provisioning environment. It is anticipated that this data definition specification can be used together with *w2* in an environment that utilizes both OMA DM and OMA CP enablers.

### 4.1 Version 1.0 Functionality

The BMO V1.0 introduced following functionalities:

- Support browser favorites settings
- Support browser homepage settings
